Please drop off all donations to the Bal Harbour Recreation Center (18 Bal Bay Dr.) during normal operating hours (Monday - Friday, 9:00am to 5:00pm). The Recreation Center is located across from Village Hall.

Bal Harbour Village is partnering with the Homestead Farmworkers Association (a 501(c)3 non-profit organization) to provide Thanksgiving food baskets to 100 families* of migrant farmworkers who were financially impacted by Hurricane Irma.

The deadline to drop-off donations is **Monday, November 20th**.

Items to bring for a complete basket:

- Frozen Turkey (9 to 12 lb.)
- 3 lb. Sweet Potatoes (Non-canned)
- 1 lb. Dry Pinto Beans
- 2 -10oz. Bags of Green Beans (Fresh or Frozen/Non-canned)
- 1 Can of Cranberry sauce
- 1 Dessert - Pie or Cake (Store-bought preferred)

**Average family size is 5 to 6 people*

Donations will be delivered to the Association's office in Homestead on Tuesday, November 21st.
