## Summary of Activities and Events

### Code Enforcement

Code Enforcement Officers (CEOs) discovered demolition work occurring inside a beachside condominium building. Workers lifted old flooring and were remodeling a social room. CEOs checked with the Building Department and learned the building did not have proper permits for the work. CEOs posted a Stop Work Order, issued a code violation, and directed the building's administration to contact the Building Department for proper permitting.

### Criminal Investigations

The Criminal Investigations Division (CID) is investigating an auto theft that occurred in the gated community. Two unknown males entered the victim's driveway, managed to start the vehicle's engine, and drove away with the victim's Lamborghini SUV. Detectives responded to the scene and immediately commenced the investigation. Detectives are currently working with the Lamborghini corporation and multi-agency auto theft task forces to develop information about possible suspects.

**Baker Act**

Officers responded to a report of a male in mental crisis and threatening self-harm. Upon arriving on the scene and making contact with the male, officers were able to de-escalate the situation. Officers transported him to Aventura Hospital under the Baker Act provision to be treated and further evaluated.

**Stolen Vehicle**

The victim told officers he parked his vehicle in the driveway the previous morning, he discovered the vehicle missing when he returned the next day. A review of his security camera footage revealed two unknown males entered the vehicle and drove off. The Criminal Investigations Division is currently following up on several leads to recover the vehicle and identify the subjects.
