SUBJECT: Bal Harbour Police Department - FDOT Northeast Community Traffic Safety Program Event Results

The purpose of this Letter to Council (LTC) is to share information with you a traffic safety event conducted in Bal Harbour Village.

The Bal Harbour Police Department, in conjunction with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six, through their NE Community Traffic Safety Team program conducted a multi-agency traffic safety enforcement and educational detail on Wednesday, October 13, from 8 a.m. to noon. Law enforcement directed their efforts on the Collins Avenue and 96th Street corridors.

The primary objective of the operation encompassed aggressive and distracted driving, red-light and speeding violations, seatbelt usage, move-over law compliance, cyclist/pedestrian safety and general traffic safety.

Police Officers from the Town of Bay Harbor Islands, City of Sunny Isles Beach, City of North Miami, Miami-Dade County, City of Miami Beach, North Bay Village and Town of Golden Beach assisted with this operation. This operation resulted in the issuance of 106 traffic citations and 25 written warnings. There were also 155 instances where educational materials regarding traffic safety were shared with motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.
