## Upcoming Traffic Impacts

- February 3, 4 & 5, 2023

Below is information on upcoming events and activities taking place this weekend, February 3 through 5, 2023, which will impact traffic in the area.

Bay Harbor Islands Event - Bay Harbor Islands is hosting an Art Festival next weekend, February 4 and 5, as part of their 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebrations. The event will take place on Kane Concourse (96<sup>th</sup> Street), and as a result, they will be closing the eastbound lanes of Kane Concourse, from W. Bay Harbor Drive to E. Bay Harbor Drive, and reducing traffic to one lane in each direction, on the north side of the road. This closure will be in effect from 10 am on Friday, February 3, and continue through 11 pm on Sunday, February 5.

- Location: Kane Concourse (96<sup>th</sup> Street) from W. Bay Harbor Drive to E. Bay Harbor Drive
- Starting: Friday, February 3, 10 am
- Running through: Sunday, February 5, 11 pm

Bal Harbour Village UIIP Work - The Village's contractor will be performing pipe bursting on Bal Bay Drive as part of the Utility Infrastructure Improvement project. This work will require the closure of Bal Bay Drive, from Park Drive south to 96<sup>th</sup> Street, and as a result, will require the closure of the Bal Bay Drive exit gate from the gated community. This closure will be in place from 8 am on Saturday, February 4 and continue through 8 pm on Sunday, February 5. The intersection of Bal Bay Drive and 96<sup>th</sup> Street will be manned at all times during this closure, to allow access in case of emergency (for police and fire). Local traffic will be required to utilize the main entrance/exit on Collins Avenue.

- Location: Bal Bay Drive from Park Drive south to 96<sup>th</sup> Street
- Starting: Saturday, February 4, 8 am
- Running through: Sunday, February 5, 8 pm
